STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- Store away from incompatible substances and excessive heat.

- Avoid exposure to high temperatures or direct sunlight..

SPILL AND LEAK PROCEDURES

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- OCCUPATIONAL SPILL - Stop leak if you can do it without risk. For small spills, take up with sand or other absorbent material and place into clean, dry containers for later disposal. For larger spills, dike far ahead of spill for later disposal. Keep unnecessary people away and isolate hazard areas.

OCCUPATIONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- VENTILATION - Provide local exhaust or general dilution ventilation to keep potential exposure to airborne contaminants as low as possible.
- RESPIRATOR - None required under normal use conditions.
- CLOTHING - Protective clothing (impervious to liquids) is required where splashing of product may occur.
